Design made following European Directive requirements and according to EC certification

- Monolithic hull design in polyester
- Monolithic structural counter moulding laminated and stuck to
 hull
- Injected sandwich hull (glass fibre and balsa wood) Diamond tip type non-slip covering
- Deck hull join screwed, stuck and banded with 1 soild wood bulwark, screwed
- Cast iron fixed keel fixed with bolts and stainless steel veneer and stuck
- Hung rudder with stainless steel stock
- · White coloured hull Hull decorated in pearl grey
